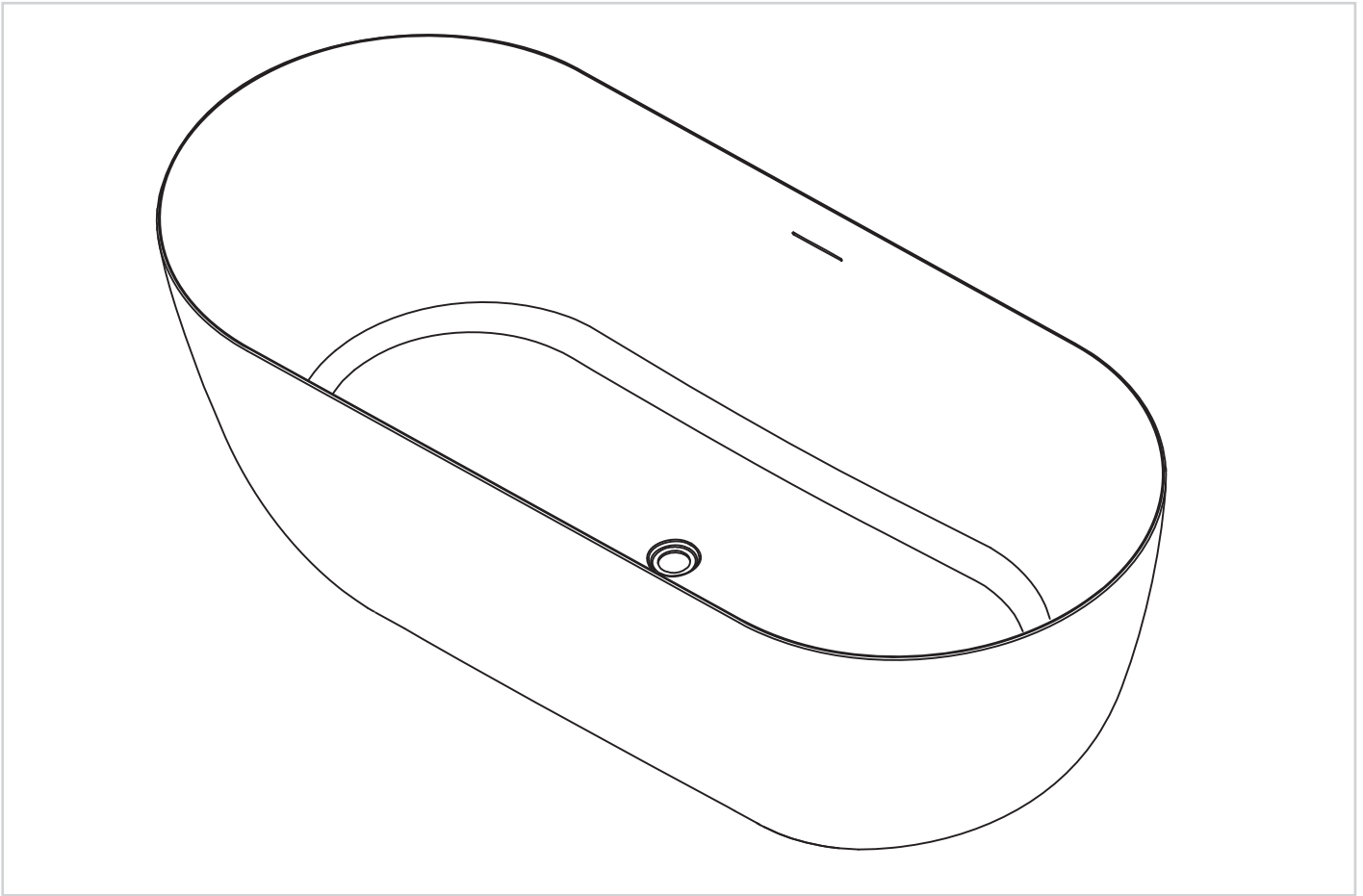

BEFORE YOU START

Important Pre-Installation Notes

Remove all packaging and check the fitting for damage before starting installation.

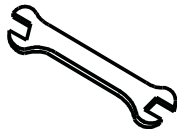
Before starting any installation please consider the following: before drilling into walls, check that there are no hidden electrical wires, cables or water supply pipes. This can be checked with the aid of an electronic detector.

If power tools are used do not forget to:

- Wear eye protection
- Unplug equipment after use

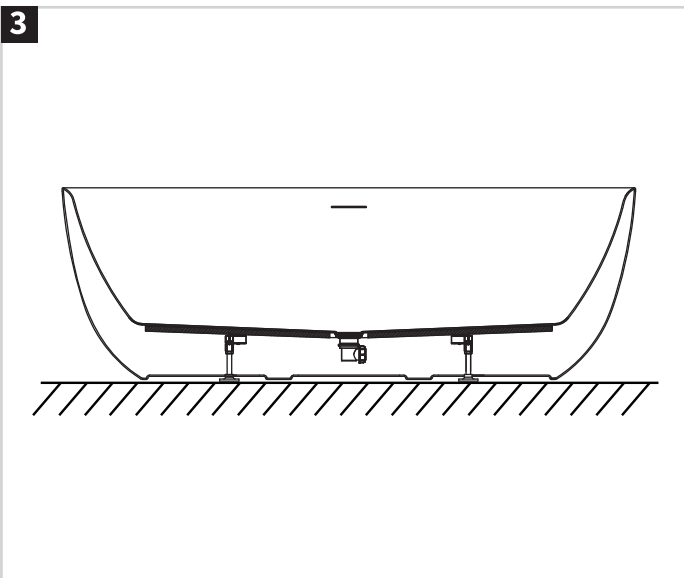
INSTALLATION



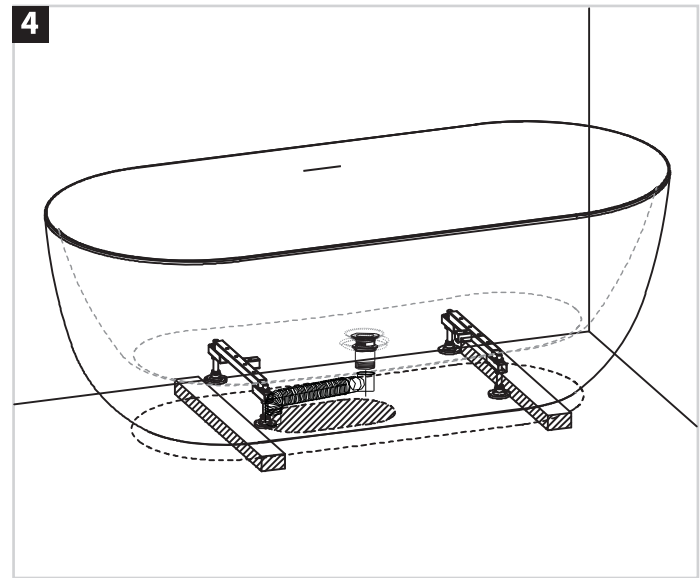
This bath must be installed on a flat and level surface. Remove any humps from the floor before installing. Under floor access is required for plumbing of bath tub waste.



Waste connection is dependant on the site situation; final decision about installation of waste connection should be taken by a suitably qualified person.

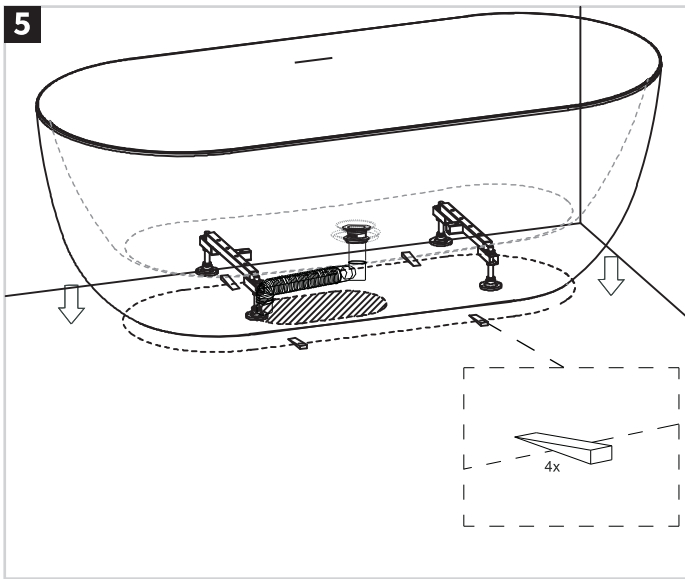


Adjust the legs to ensure they are level with the bottom edge of the bath.

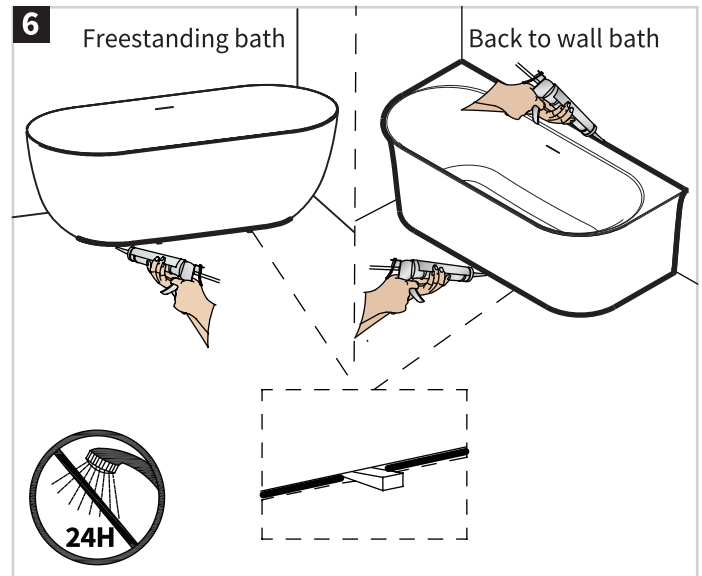


Place the bath on two wooden blocks over the waste connections. Connect the waste. Fill the bath with water and check for leaks from the waste before removing the blocks. Avoid the leg set underneath the bath when you place the bath on two wooden blocks.

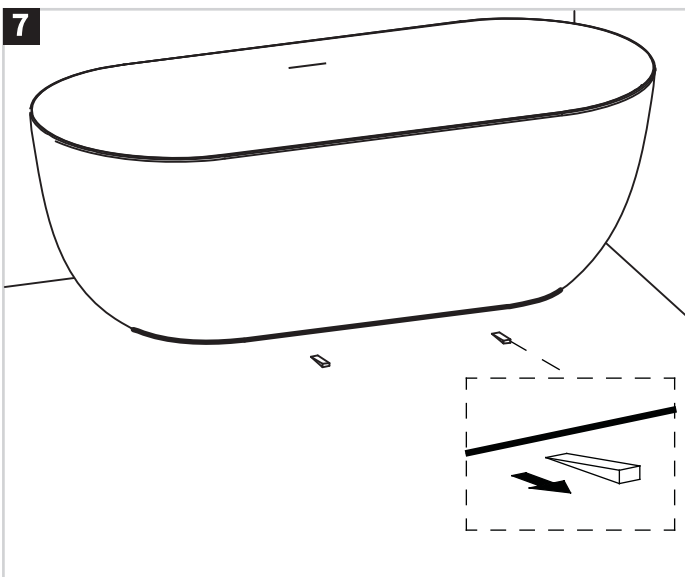
INSTALLATION



Place the wedges in position.



Freestanding bath: Apply a bead of clear silicone sealant around the bottom of the bath to secure it to the floor.
Back to wall bath: Apply a bead of clear silicone sealant on the joint between the bath and the wall.
Should maintenance access be needed the silicone can be released by cutting round it with a sharp knife.



The wedges can now be disposed off.

DAILY CLEANING

Use a soft, dampened sponge or cloth to clean the bath. Never use an abrasive material such as a brush or scouring pad to clean surfaces.

IMPORTANT

Gloss finish:

If any scratches occur during installation these can be removed by rubbing with a 1500+ grit waterproof abrasive paper and water. Re-polish the surface afterwards using a neutral automotive colour restorer or household metal polish. For best results limit sanding to the smallest possible area around the scratch. It may be possible to polish very fine scratches away without using abrasive papers: scrubbing gently with a soft brush or plastic pad (not metal scouring pad) and a mildly abrasive cream cleaner. Afterwards scrub the whole area with plenty of clean water and re-polish as before.

Matt finish:

- Matt finish bathtub cannot be polished with sandpaper or polishing paste.
- Scratches on the surface of matt finish bathtub cannot be repaired, please use soft material to cover the bathtub during installation to prevent it from being scratched.



It is advisable always to run in some cold water before turning on the hot tap. We recommend the hot water be no more than 65 degrees C. Extreme heat such as that generated by cigarettes or portable heaters can damage Acrylic surfaces. Do not use such items near your bath.
